

Scunthorpe Indoor Bowls Club
Order of Play when a Rink of Four or a Triples Team is One Player Short

There are three possible procedures referred to here as **A, B & C**.

The defaulting team (ie one short) is called “D” and their opponents “N” (normal).

In all three cases D has no number 2. When there are 3 players instead of 4 there are two alternatives “A” or “B”.

Order of Play in Rinks or Fours Play

In “A” ALL players send 2 bowls and there is NO adjustment to the final score.
 Order of sending bowls in Fours...one player short in team D.

In alternative play “B” D’s players number 1 & 3 each send 3 bowls BUT team D has 25% of it’s score deducted with fractions being taken into account.

Order of Paly in Triples Matches

In Triples matches there is only one option available, and applies to both EBA and EBF... ALL players send 3 bowls.
 The order of play is as follows below.
